"RESOLUTION IN SUPPORT OF ASSEMBLY BILL 351"

WHEREAS, Temecula Valley Unified School District believes the health and physical fitness of our students is essential to their learning and well being;

WHEREAS, Temecula Valley Unified School District believes it is important to provide students with quality physical fitness opportunities;

WHEREAS, Assembly Bill 351 (AB351) provides students with more opportunities to participate in interscholastic athletic programs, marching band, drill team, and Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps while meeting the P.E. instructional minutes requirement outlined in state law.

WHEREAS, Statewide, parents and other supporters annually spend and raise millions of dollars to support their students co-curricular programs.

WHEREAS, These programs have been, are and should continue to be an important part of the California high school experience;

WHEREAS, eliminating this P.E. credit option will significantly reduce the number of students able to participate in interscholastic athletic programs, marching band, drill team, and Junior Reserve Officer Training Corps;


